The St. Vincent de Paul Society of Billings, established in 1972, has been a steadfast pillar of support for the homeless and those facing extreme poverty in our community. As the only daytime shelter and no barrier place in Billings, they are



committed to providing a safe haven where everyone is welcomed with dignity and respect.

This year, St. Vincent de Paul will serve 100,000 meals, because more homeless or suffering food insecurity are coming for the first time. Their support spans but is not limited to providing donated clothing, sober living assistance, and 1x rent or utility aid to avoid or end homelessness.

Their clothing shop, stocked entirely through in-kind donations, allows our Friends to choose clean, seasonally appropriate clothing, helping them maintain their dignity in challenging times. St. Vincent de Paul and RiverStone Health have a special partnership bringing access to healthcare to those in need.

In their daytime shelter, Riverstone Health conducts complimentary healthcare services twice weekly, which have been instrumental in saving lives. Together with Riverstone Health, St. Vincent de Paul provides hope and a promise of continued support to vulnerable families, women and men.
