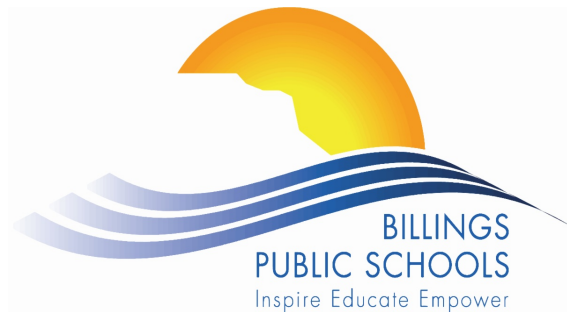

The Campaign for Daylis Stadium

The campaign to renovate Daylis Stadium is gaining momentum!

The vision is to build a modern, accessible and safe stadium that serves students and the community for generations to come. The plan is to break ground after football season this fall, around the first part of December.

Charter Schools

In the fall of 2024, Billings Public Schools opened three public charter schools after receiving approval for state funding: The Billings Opportunity School, The Billings Early College School and the Billings Multilingual Academy.

The Billings Opportunity School offers smaller class sizes and proficiency-based learning to empower students to continue on their path toward graduation.

The Billings Early College School offers an opportunity for students to earn college credits up to an Associate Degree while still in high school.

The Billings Multilingual Academy supports a diverse group of multilingual students as they continue to develop their academic English skills.
