- Orchard Elementary

- Senior High

Our school clinics located inside Medicine Crow Middle School and Orchard Elementary School are open to all students enrolled in Billings School District 2, their family members and District 2 faculty and staff.

Our Billings Senior High clinic provides medical care to Senior High students and staff, with on-site behavioral health services coming soon.

Partner Spotlight: Tumbleweed



Tumbleweed takes a proactive approach to preventing homelessness and school dropouts through schoolbased services, equipping vulnerable youth with the tools and support they need to succeed.

They also proudly lead the region's Chafee Program, empowering foster youth as they transition to adulthood and providing them with guidance and resources until their 21st birthday, ensuring they don't have to navigate life's challenges alone.

Tumbleweed is one of few organizations in Montana addressing the hidden epidemic of human trafficking among minors. They work to identify victims and connect them with the care and support they desperately need.

organization that has been working to end homelessness among youth and young adults of Billings and its neighboring communities for nearly 50 years.

Every program, service, and effort they undertake is rooted in the belief that every young person deserves a safe place to call home and the opportunity to thrive.

At the heart of Tumbleweed's efforts is the Drop-In Resource Center—a sanctuary where young people can meet their basic needs (e.g., hot meals, food pantry, showers, clothing, etc.) find safety, and take the first steps toward a brighter future. The resource center partners with the Youth Homelessness Demonstration Project to create a lifeline for youth experiencing homelessness.

Together, they ensure that homelessness is not just addressed but transformed into a rare, brief, and non-recurring chapter in their lives.
