RiverStone Health Service Spotlight

The Montana Cancer Control Program gives access to cancer screening and diagnostic exams to women aged 21 to 65 years old for breast and cervical cancer. Service as a source of financial assistance, the program has served over 79,000 Montana women over the last 28 years. There are approximately 900 practitioners across the State of Montana currently enrolled in the program to provide screening services.

Guidelines for Eligibility:

Patients must meet the following criteria to be eligible:

- Age 21 years and older for cervical screenings
- Age 40 years and over for breast screenings
- Make an annual income of less than 250% of the Federal poverty level
- Uninsured or underinsured.
 - Underinsured is any out-of-pocket financial burden to the patient.

To determine eligibility, patients must thoroughly complete an enrollment form, click button below to learn more and see form.

*Patients must see providers that are currently enrolled in the MCCP program for any covered services.

What the Program Covers:

- Clinical Breast Exams (including the office visit)
- Initial mammogram, breast tomosynthesis, additional views, breast ultrasound, and breast biopsy.
- Screening Breast MRI, must meet guidelines for risk factors
- Pelvic ultrasound and endometrial biopsy on case-by-case basis
- Pap test (Including the office visit)
- Cervical biopsy
- *A patient with breast or cervical cancer diagnosis who utilized the MCSP and does not have insurance will be eligible for treatment services through the Montana Cancer Control Program. Please contact cancer control staff to fill out the necessary forms.*

Site 8’s local office is housed at RiverStone Health serves Carbon, Stillwater and Yellowstone Counties. Wyoming residents who attend appointments in Carbon, Stillwater and Yellowstone Counties may also receive services. Follow the click to call button below or call 406.247.3215 for assistance.

YWCA Billings provides emergency and transitional services to survivors of domestic violence, sexual assault, and human trafficking in order to help them break out of the cycle of violence.

YWCA Billings Programs:

- Complete Confidentiality
- Secure Emergency Shelter
- 24/7 Call and Text Helplines
- Legal Advocacy
- Case Management and Referrals
- Safety Plans
- Financial Education
- Housing Assistance

YWCA Billings' offers **emergency services** at no cost to survivors of domestic violence, sexual assault, and/or human trafficking. Services include secure Emergency Shelter in Yellowstone and Big Horn County, 24/7 phone and text help lines and hospital accompaniment for survivors of sexual assault.

- Gateway Horizons - Offers refuge for those fleeing domestic and sexual violence, or human trafficking
- 24- Hour help Lines - Callers receive information, guidance and support from trained Victim Support Specialists
- Hospital Accompaniment - Support

YWCA Billings is dedicated to saving and changing lives. They offer individuals safe shelter, and affordable housing with transitional services that offer a hand up rather than a hand out—helping people gain solid footing and break out of the cycle of violence. The YWCA is also committed to YWCA USA's mission to eliminate racism, empower women and promote peace, justice, freedom and dignity for all.

YWCA Billings services address the trauma of domestic violence, sexual assault, and human trafficking. Their **transitional services** empower individuals in securing housing, employment, emotional health, personal safety—and ultimately, a life free from violence.

- Case Management - Provides support and resource connections for victims as they create a vision for their future.
- Gateway Vista Apartments - Gateway Vista offers affordable housing for low-income individuals and families
- Transitional and Rapid Re-Housing - YWCA's Housing Navigator helps locate safe affordable housing and secure rent assistance as needed
- Legal Advocacy - On-site legal support provided by a licensed attorney for civil legal needs.
- Northern Lights FJC - Providing safety planning, support, and coordination of free local services for victims of domestic abuse.
