A majority of these services fall under our Senior Helping Hands and Prevention of Elder Abuse programs. Prevention of Elder Abuse program houses the representative payee and case management services, and Senior Helping Hands helps seniors remain independent in their own homes by providing recite care. homemaking, personal care and nursing services. In order for clients to be considered for services by either program, a completed application must be submitted in order to determine eligibility. Once the application is completed and submitted, the appropriate Program Manager will reach out to schedule a time to meet with you and/or your loved one.
